The Florida Department of Health in Collier County (DOH-Collier) is working to combat COVID19 by continuing to offer testing for residents. This is not antibody testing.

Symptomatic testing only. Please call the DOH-Collier screening line at (239) 252-6220.

- Appointment only, drive-thru testing – all ages

Thursdays – 9:00am-3:00pm

For an appointment call (239) 252-8230 on Tuesdays – 9:00am-4:00pm.

No referral needed for testing. Clients do not need to have symptoms and will be asked to provide their name, contact phone number, address, date of birth.

Testing at DOH-Collier Immokalee site: 419 North First Street, Immokalee, FL 34142

- Appointment only – all ages

Daily, Monday-Friday – 8:00am-5:00pm

Symptomatic testing only. Please call the DOH-Collier screening line at (239) 252-6220.

- Walk-up testing – all ages

Monday, Wednesday, Friday – 9:00am-5:00pm

Sunday – 12:00pm-6:00pm

No referral needed for testing. Clients do not need to have symptoms and will be asked to provide their name, contact phone number, address, date of birth.

Testing at Healthcare Network's Nichols Community Health Center: 12655 Collier Blvd., Naples, 34116

- Drive-thru testing – all ages

Saturday, July 11, 2020 & July 18, 2020 – 9:00am-1:00pm

No referral needed for testing. Clients do not need to have symptoms and will be asked to provide their name, contact phone number, address, date of birth.

Lightning, heavy rain, or gusty winds can slow operations or shut down the site.

Through a partnership the Department of Emergency Management, Florida National Guard, Florida Department of Health, Lee County, and Collier County offers drive-thru testing at Century Link Sports Complex.

Testing at Century Link Sports Complex: 14100 Ben C. Pratt/Six Mile Cypress Pkwy, Fort Myers, FL 33916

- Drive-thru testing – 18 years and over

Monday-Sunday – 9:00am-5:00pm

Last car to be admitted through the gate is 3:00pm or when testing capacity reaches its limit. No referral is needed for testing. Clients do not need to have symptoms and will be asked to show a valid ID for everyone being tested.

Lightning, heavy rain, or gusty winds can slow operations or shut down the site.

Results for all testing sites take approximately 7 days. You will receive information at the testing site regarding how to access your results. Testing is also available through primary care physicians and urgent care facilities. Please call ahead prior to going to the office.

Florida Health Metrics

Florida monitors COVID-19 in multiple ways, including emergency department visits, case counts, and laboratory test data. Charts shown here summarize these critical data elements by week for the last six weeks, based on data from ESSENCE-FL¹ and Merlin².

Dates shown are the week start date and contain the total counts for that entire week of data from the starting Sunday through Saturday.

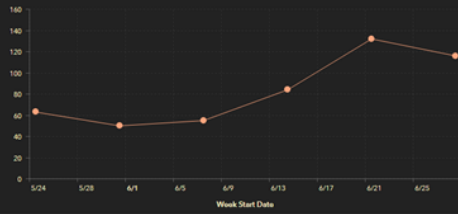

¹ Early Notification of Community-based Epidemics (ESSENCE-FL) is Florida's syndromic surveillance system.

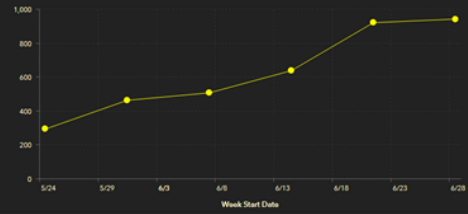
² Merlin is Florida's reportable disease surveillance application where case and laboratory data are managed.

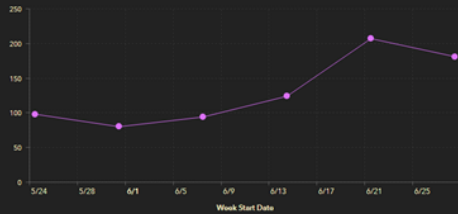
ED VISITS WITH INFLUENZA-LIKE ILLNESS
