Patient Visits

Avow volunteers may provide respite visits to the caregivers of our patients so that they can run errands, go to appointments or just have some time to recharge. Volunteers may also provide companionship visits to Avow patients residing in skilled nursing or assisted living facilities, or in the Avow Frances Georgeson Hospice House Inpatient Unit.

PAWS visits

Avow volunteers and their Pet Partners or PAWS Assistance Dogs, Inc. certified pets may visit Avow patients in skilled and assisted living facilities.

Avow Kids and Adult Bereavement

Volunteers may assist Avow Kids staff with children's bereavement programs such as grief support day and weekend camp, as well as run errands, make calls and assist with administrative tasks.

We Honor Veterans Volunteers

Avow volunteers with current or retired veteran status are encouraged to participate in Avow's We Honor Veterans Program by making patient visits to fellow veterans, provide recognition of service during our We Honor Veteran's patient recognition ceremonies, participate in Avow sponsored campus and community events, and act as an ambassador to Avow in the veteran community.
